I also act as appellate counsel for Legal Aid clients in the Supreme Court of B.C. and the Court of Appeal; to that end, I most recently argued *R. v. Schneider*, a case about suspended sentence availability in fentanyl trafficking in 2019.

I presently sit on the Interior Virtual Bail committee, Judge Dohm's Corrections committee, and the Criminal Tariff Advisory Committee.

I live in West Kelowna with my husband, my two daughters, and a large and stupid (but exquisitely handsome) dog. I am a licensed electro-fisher and a ski instructor, I almost never pay my bills on time, and was once told that I am uniquely unsuited to government.
